<p>Primary Skills – Year 9 - 11 The course is run in half-day sessions providing an excellent opportunity for young people to re-engage with learning through a practical, hands-on experience in a full size, well equipped workshop. Students work on a variety of motor vehicles learning basic mechanics with an overarching ethos of teamwork in an adult environment. Health and Safety is a core skill learned on enrolment. The course can be adapted to meet the individual needs and capabilities of each student. They are taught in small groups with experienced instructors.</p> <p>Skills Students gain transferable skills that enhance their learning and employment prospects. In addition experience has shown massive improvements in attendance, punctuality, and most of all in self-esteem, confidence and communication skills.</p> <p>Awards Currently students receive certificates from SKIDZ recognising their achievements in Health & Safety, Basic Car Mechanics, and other individual skills. In the future it is hoped a few will be able to access the ABC Level 1 Award. A number of students who demonstrate their skill at an early stage can enrol on the exam course in the Foundation Learning Tier.</p> <p>Cost: £ per session per student.</p> <p>Start Dates Students can be enrolled onto the Primary Skills Course at any stage in the term or academic year.</p>	<p>ABC Level 1 Award – Year 10 Designed to develop skills and understanding of maintenance aspects of the motor trade, including Health and Safety. The course is Award Level and can be completed in 1 year, leading onto the Certificate Level Course for the second year if appropriate to abilities. Units include a selection from Health and Safety, Basic Mechanics, tyres, brakes, engine fluids, body work, and road studies. The course is 60% practical/40% classroom based. It will take place in 2 hour sessions. Pass 20% = Points Score 25. It is the entry to the Foundation Learning Tier.</p> <p>Assessment: Modules are assessed internally. An exam centre moderation officer visits SKIDZ to assess the quality of provision and internal assessment. Qualification is made up of 1 Mandatory unit and 3 out of 18 optional units.
